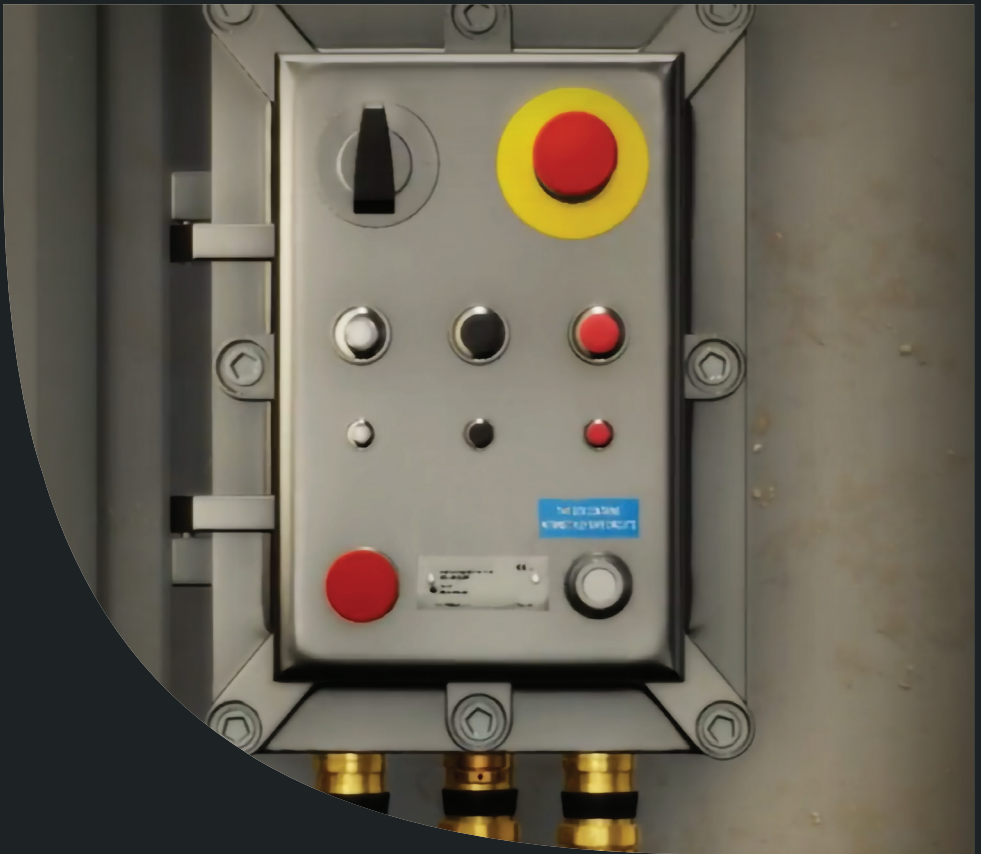




IECEX MARKING of electrical equipment
